



COVID-19 Vaccine Updates

What We Know Today: Because of the limited supply of vaccine, at present, shots will be available to NH residents through State sponsored vaccination clinics for people ages 65+ or for younger adults with two or more qualifying [medical conditions](#).

Caregivers of children under the age of 16 who have two or more qualifying medical conditions are also eligible to receive a vaccine at this stage in the distribution process. [Click here](#) to use a tool to determine if you are eligible for vaccination in this phase.

Vaccines will be distributed through approved sites throughout New Hampshire. For the Berlin-Gorham area, a vaccine clinic will be established at the former Brown School on Norway Street. Advanced registration is required.

In order to schedule yourself or your loved ones to receive the vaccine, you must call 2-1-1 or visit the website that the state has created for Covid-19 registration. That website address is www.vaccines.nh.gov.

We understand the frustration that many are feeling, and ask for your patience. We are working closely with AVH and other community partners to bring the vaccine to our community, and will keep you updated as we learn more.
