**Priority for cervical cancer screening:** Women who have never been screened OR have not been screened in over 5 years. Women age 21 to 64 years – Screening with Pap test every 3 years OR screening with a Pap test and HPV test every 5 years for women age 30 to 64 who want to lengthen the screening interval. Most women enrolled in the BCCP who are diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer can be enrolled in Medicaid.
